- **Two builders mime**
    - get as many people as possible involved - suggesting actions for each paragraph/phrase...
    - (script from SU BSWG material, 2013)
  - Earlier in chapter 6, Jesus has talked about the kinds of things his followers should do:
    - love God and do what pleases him - even when no-one else is watching
    - tell the truth and keep their promises, so that others can rely on every word they say
    - look out for others and do all they can to help them
    - forgive those who hurt them
    - trust God and talk to him about everything
  - **Challenge to put into practise - this is wisdom**
    - prayer, asking help to do that...

## Two Foundations

- Whitburn houses by the motorway that fell down mine:
  - they looked the same as the houses over the road from them...
  - little on the outside to distinguish...
  - but their foundations were compromised...
- In parable, what made the difference between the two houses when the time of testing came?
  - foundations - laid over time, hidden from view
- Point of testing, point of choice - will I follow God and stand up for him or not - comes after the earlier choices to lay foundations

## Two Outcomes

- Life secure / life unfounded
