## WDJD: He Changed (1)

- Step ladder - change of perspective
  - photos from up high and down low... onto screen
- Jesus changed the perspective of the disciples:
  - they'd begun to see who he was, so he took them up the mountain and allowed them to see more fully who he really was!
- What did they see from their new perspective?
  - glory - shining, God's presence
  - Moses - law, Jesus stands in fulfilment of it not opposition to it
  - Elijah - prophets, those who called people back to following God and knowing him; Jesus also fulfils all that the prophets sought to do
  - mountain - a "something important" place
- In passing again, notice when this happens - when Jesus is praying with the disciples
  - if we want to see stuff happening, see God at work, it often seems to happen around prayer...!
- *We are going to pray now... prayer and Lord's prayer*

**WDJD: He Changed (2)**

- What kind of things would the following people say to us?
  - and should we listen to them?
  - why should we listen (or not listen) to them?
- **Teacher** (image)
- **Bully** (image)
- **Parents** (image)
- **Friends** (image)
- As a result of seeing more clearly who Jesus was his friends were to **listen to him**
  - (**Lord image**)
  - how do we listen to Jesus? (eg **Bible, prayer, other Christians**)
  - and how do we help other people to have a fresh perspective on Jesus so they can hear what he is saying to them? (**ask questions, tell stories**)
