 - something to really, genuinely look forward to
- Where do we picture ourselves at the heavenly banquet imagine!
- Picture of banquet often often intertwined with picture of a wedding banquet:
 - with Jesus as groom... and the church, us, as bride!
 - we will be at the centre!
